This cemetery is completely overgrown. It has not been cleared for years. There seem to be more graves but this is all the markers we could find. It is too overgrown (in May) to find graves marked with fieldstones-or fallen markers. There is no driveway up to it from the road and it is not visible from the road. It is not fenced in.

We believe this to be Solomon Carter, son of Solomon and Francis Johnson Carter, who married Harriett Carter 22 Mar. 1845 in Knox Co.. They had a son Richard A. Carter (from Census) born 1850, Who would be the R.A. Carter in this Cemetery.
