



Dishman Springs may be easily reached by rail or motor. Barbourville is located on the L. & N. Railroad, 188 miles from Louisville, 202 miles from Cincinnati and 97 miles from

Knoxville. Pullman accomodations may be had to Barbourville. The hotel bus meets all trains.

The distance by motor is about the same as via rail. Barbourville is situated on the Boone Way. While a very scenic and interesting trip, this road, due to construction work, is not good in wet weather. When dry, during the summer months the highway, which is now being converted into one of the best trunk North and South roads across the State is easily passable and the trip may be made without difficulty.
