 We specialize in giving worth-while boys and girls a good start on the road to success.



Tuition in grades from \$3.00 to \$3.50 per month.




Our Buildings-

The view on the preceding page shows the Administration Building. New improvements have recently been made, providing large and well-lighted class rooms.

The Boys Home is shown on the left margin. This building has two good bath rooms, and is steam heated. Every effort is made to have wholesome and home-like influences for the boys who stay in this building.


Brown Hall, which is the girls' home, is seen on the extreme right. This building is one of the best equipped of our entire plant. A large dining room for all boarding students is located in the basement. Boarding students have modern conveniences in the dormitories, and are also very close to the school building.



Athletics—

We do not specialize in athletics, but we are proud of our showing in this field. Some views of our athletes are shown. We believe in the all round development of the student, and our athletic program is constructed with that ideal in mind.

Remember, as you study these pictures, that we stress thorough work in the basic studies of the school curriculum. A photograph cannot show this creditable feature of our work. But the mere study of books will not give to young people the best preparation for a complete life. Some means for wholesome play and health-giving exercise are needed.



Our Aim-

A real department of physical education is our aim. This means that our athletic department is conducted, not so much to train winning teams, as it is to secure the best physical development of the pupil. We want our boys and girls to have strong minds in strong bodies.

Our equipment for physical education is at present deficient. We need a good gymnasium, and with the support of our many friends who believe in good health, we hope soon to have such a building.

Schools are coming more and more to realize the importance of caring for the physical well-being of their students. Our students are urged to enter into some athletic games, or have an approved form for securing systematic exercise each day.



For Young Men-

Base ball, foot ball, basket ball, and track teams provide ample opportunity for our young men to develop their bodies along systematic lines.

The importance of games in the development of character is stressed. The boy that learns to play a game energetically, honestly and on the square, and who can also take defeat in good spirit, may be depended upon to play a good part in the game of life.

Many boys find this school a good place in which to begin their athletic career.



Learn to Play-

It is the happy privilege of children and young people to learn to play. Our students are urged to come with that agreeable spirit which will lead them to enter into our school life in all its fullness.

The student that is pleasant and agreeable with his fellows at play, is very likely to become a good citizen in every respect. There is no better place for cultivating the social nature of young people than on the playground.

Much study is being given to making the life of students in the dormitories as pleasant and home-like as possible. Most of our students leave home with the purpose of adapting themselves to the new surroundings, and of helping to make other students happy in their new school home.

Our program includes opportunity for the proper physical training of all girls who enroll in the Southeast Kentucky Baptist School.

Good health is a priceless boon, both for boys and girls, and we are anxious in every way possible to secure healthy development of every student that comes under our care.

With our emphasis upon the basic virtues and a thorough grounding in the elemental school subjects, plus a good physical development, our girls are equipped as well as any school can make them for a useful life in the home, or in business.



Preparation for High School—
